Apprentice plumbers assist in the assembly, installation and repair of plumbing, water flow and drainage systems in accordance with city, state and federal plumbing codes. This may include everything from digging trenches for new pipeline to installing new hardware for faucets, showers and toilets in residential homes, commercial buildings and industrial facilities

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Install, repair and maintain domestic, commercial or industrial plumbing fixtures and systems

Locate and mark positions for pipe connections, passage holes and fixtures in walls and floors

Cut opening in walls and floors to accommodate pipe and pipe fittings

Measure, cut, bend and thread pipes using hand and power tools or machines

Join pipes using couplings, clamps, screws, bolts, cement or soldering, brazing and welding equipment

Test pipes for leaks using air and water pressure gauges

Perform other duties as assigned

Professional Accountability:

1. Attends assigned meetings and demonstrates active participation
2. Seeks/accepts training to learn new skills and maintain current competencies.
3. Active participation in Apprentice school

4. Works effectively and cooperatively in groups/teams to ensure the delivery of efficient and effective Customer Service
5. Communicates effectively with supervisors and members of the team
